Program

This program is a one-year (two semesters) program. This comprehensive curriculum adopts student-centred learning practices and contemplative components like self-awareness, non-evaluative attention, concentration and insights. The graduates of the program are expected to bring systemic change to the existing educational model of teaching and learning.
